You can join us along the way, parking at Amy Tree will knock off 2 miles.


Alternatively start at South Hill church and add on 3 miles and 1 hour.

The June walk led us to Kelly Bray and followed a line of granite boundary stones and marker posts, then took us through Silver Valley, named for the number of silver mines in the area. The earliest started in 1580, later copper and tin mining was prevalent from 1774 to 1848, we had a pit stop at Harrowbarrow village hall play park, then onto Metherell, Comfort wood to Newton and on through Danescombe wood to reach the road and the church where 13 walkers were greeted by Sue, the Bell Captain at St Andrews church with a very welcome tea and biscuits and the rare opportunity to climb the tower and see the bells reinstalled in 2019.
