## Reflecting on 2022

Russia invaded Ukraine, many people have been killed and displaced, some finding their way to homes around our parish. As a consequence oil and food prices rose to record highs



COVID-19 restrictions were lifted, rising energy bills, Levelling Up, Climate Crisis, Cost-of-Living Crisis and with it protests, blockades and strikes.

Storms & Flooding & Heatwave, record temperatures here and a hose pipe ban. An earthquake between Afghanistan and Pakistan, killed over 1, 000 people. A series of heatwaves from July to August hit Europe, causing at least 53,000 deaths and causing wildfires, travel disruptions, and record high temperatures in many countries.



We've heard more about Black Lives Matter & Bird Flu.

After 70 years on the throne, marked by her Platinum Jubilee celebrations, Queen Elizabeth II died on 8<sup>th</sup> September at the age of 96. September 10<sup>th</sup> Charles III is formally proclaimed King.

Other world leaders died: Shinzo Abe, Mikhail Gorbachev, & Jiang Zemin, plus entertainers Sidney Poitier, Olivia Newton-John, Angela Lansbury, Jerry Lee Lewis, Dennis Waterman, Barry Cryer, Robbie Coltrane, Kirstie Alley, Leslie Phillips, Bernard Cribbins, James Caan, Lester Piggott, Shane Warne, Meat Loaf, Janice Long, Bill Turnbull, Christine McVie, Jethro

Boris Johnson resigned as Prime Minister, Liz Truss was elected as his successor in September, quit 50 days later, and was replaced by Rishi Sunak.

In February The Winter Olympics were held in Beijing, China, making it the first city ever to host both the Summer and Winter Olympics.

May 14<sup>th</sup> The Eurovision Song Contest UK entry performed by Sam Ryder finished in second place and it felt like a win behind the winners from Ukraine.

July England hosted EURO 22 Women's UEFA and won.

October 28<sup>th</sup> Elon Musk completes his \$44 billion acquisition of Twitter



December FIFA World Cup held in Qatar, Argentina beat France in the final

### Cornwall and Devon Sending Love to Ukraine

We have now completed EIGHT convoy runs plus some individual runs (a total of nearly 90 vans and nearing 200 tonnes of aid) and we are so grateful to everyone who has joined this worthy cause. Please support us in any way that you can as we continue to send aid to Ukraine, the vast majority of which was given by the generous people of Cornwall and Devon. **The returning vans have also brought 45 refugees to safety in the UK.**

Donations are taken to a Ukrainian contact in Warsaw who then arranges for the goods to be transported across the border. Most recently, aid has been directed to liberated towns in the Donbas region.

The organiser of the convoys, **Darren Tait** said "donations are helping, and making a difference to the quality of life of people in truly desperate situations."


**The ninth convoy will leave on 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2023 and will take everything from nappies to generators and frontline medical supplies.**



## St Sampson's Unlocked

I'm writing this before Christmas, but you will be reading it in January when Christmas is over. We will have had our **Carols by candlelight**, our **Supertots jingle ring** and our **messy tingle**. But the restoration project marches on regardless of the season!



**Our plans are drawn up and available for viewing if requested. They include a hideaway kitchen, a toilet, repairing the roof and ceiling and creating a meeting room in the Manaton Chapel.**

The faculty (Church of England planning permission) has been submitted, It is a lengthy process. The relevant statutory bodies have had their say. Historic England, The Victorian Society, The Society for the Protection of Ancient buildings & Historic Buildings and Places. The first formal round of consultation will have ended by now and the next stage started with possible changes to the plans in response to comments and objections from these organisations.

At the same time planning permission has been sought from Cornwall County Council for an air source heat pump to provide underfloor heating in the Manaton chapel, heating behind the Altar and in the proposed new toilet in the base of the tower.

**As an eco church we are looking to be as sustainable as possible.**

**It is an ambitious vision**, which is slowly happening. The windows are 75% restored, the bells dismantled and taken from the tower awaiting more funding for restoration and re-hanging. Funding is presently being sought for external masonry repairs and west door repairs. Solutions and quotes for heating are being requested.

**There are a lot of challenges to overcome**, meeting the exacting specifications of restoring a grade 1 listed building and of course the funding of this community project. We are looking to the future as well as making the building more useable now. If we want to see our local church still here serving the community in years to come, then we need to get our restoration done well.

**In 2018 the community completed a survey** and many attended a community meeting. Over 100 ideas were suggested, and these are at the heart of what St Sampson's wants to achieve for the community.

It is a right for everyone in the parish to use St Sampson's Church for baptisms, marriages, funerals and much else.

**It is your church and has been here for the community in its present form since 1333 and probably founded much earlier by St Sampson in the 5<sup>th</sup>C.**

South Hill Parish is a generous and wonderful community and St Sampson's is proud to be part of it.

## RECIPE OF THE MONTH

### POTATO CAKES



400g well mashed potato  
1 large egg lightly beaten  
2 tbsp plain flour  
Milk to mix  
Oil/knob of butter for frying  
Salt and pepper  
Add any extra's if preferred:  
Sliced spring onion, chopped fresh herbs, garlic, chilli, spices, chopped bacon, cheese..

### METHOD

Mix all ingredients together adding a little milk if too stiff (add any extras if required)  
Roll on a floured surface until 2cm thick, cut into rounds  
Heat oil and butter in a large frying pan and cook rounds in batches over medium heat for approx. 4 mins each side until crisp and golden

### Details of the P.C meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> December 2022 included the following:

**BUDGET:** Details were reviewed regarding the expected overspend for year 2022/23. The budget for 2023/24 was reviewed and the precept discussed. In the light of these discussions the precept for 23/24 will increase somewhat but remain still below 20/21 levels and include no new project spending.

**PLAY AREA EQUIPMENT:** The dual swing: one safety seat for toddlers and one normal seat has been purchased and erected in the play area, in front of the tree. The Chairman thanked Cllr. Harriet Curtis for her efforts in this regard.



**DEFIBRILLATOR:** The new defibrillator has been ordered, expected in January. The cabinet will remain unlocked which is the ambulance service preference, it is understood that this will not affect insurance.

**WINTER WEATHER:** The Parish Council has a supply of salt for use on public roads. If needed, parishioners should contact the Council. The possibility of obtaining grit bins was discussed.

## Church Matters

### 'I DON'T BELIEVE IN GOD'

I expect many, like myself, have heard this response when the conversation turns to church, religion or faith. On occasions I have responded by asking what kind of god they don't believe in. Invariably I end up agreeing with them; I don't believe in the kind of god they describe either.

**The writers of the Bible, particularly the psalms**, see their God as indescribable and beyond human comprehension but cite what can be observed in the world around us and the wider universe as providing evidence for His existence (Psalm 19 and Romans 1 for instance).

In short, the 'why' and the 'who' behind the 'what' and the 'how' that science focusses on.

**Christians believe that there is a creator and designer behind what we observe** and a purpose to its existence, basing their beliefs on the wisdom of centuries recoded in the Bible.

Interestingly, the case for there being a design behind what we observe has been strengthened since science has understood that the universe is neither infinite nor always existed. A finite universe which had a beginning puts limits on the probability of an event occurring. For instance, some statisticians have calculated that the probability of even the simplest life form appearing by chance is so small as to be discounted as a possible explanation for its existence!

**So, does this leave Christians with a remote and inaccessible God?** Not at all! The Christian God is one who reveals Himself to those who are searching for Him. That revelation comes through the world around us, through the wisdom revealed to the Bible's writers and ultimately through Jesus.

CS Lewis once wrote: **'A man who was merely a man and said the sort of things Jesus said would not be a great moral teacher. He would either be a lunatic—on a level with the man who says he is a poached egg—or else he would be the Devil of Hell. You must make your choice. Either this man was, and is, the Son of God: or else a madman or something worse.... You can shut Him up for a fool, you can spit at Him and kill Him as a demon; or you can fall at His feet and call Him Lord and God. But let us not come up with any patronising nonsense about His being a great human teacher. He has not left that open to us. He did not intend to.'** Mere Christianity.

**What do you believe?**

Are the claims of Jesus those of a madman or is he who he claims to be? If the former, Jesus and Christianity are totally irrelevant. If the latter, then who Jesus is and what he teaches are of the utmost importance, a matter of life and death in fact!

Perhaps 2023 is the year to decide which side of the fence you are on.
