




Built in the 1890's, this bakery has been restored under new ownership, and with new ownership comes a new life!



#### **RECIPE OF THE MONTH** Gluten Free Lime and Coconut Cake

125g Rice Flour
2 tsp Gluten Free baking powder
1 tsp Xanthan Gum (optional)
175g butter, softened
Finely grated zest of 3-4 limes (keep juice for drizzle)
175g caster sugar,

plus 75g for drizzle 3 eggs

50g desiccated coconut

Heat oven to 180 degrees C, Gas mark 4 Grease and line a 1 litre loaf tin



Sift the flour, baking powder and xanthan gum in a bowl.

In another bowl, cream the butter and lime zest, then add the sugar and beat until light and creamy.

Add the eggs one at a time, alternating with a spoonful of flour. Fold in the remaining flour and the coconut.

Pour into the tin and bake for 40-45 minutes.

Mix 75g caster sugar and lime juice.

When the cake is cooked, prick all over and drizzle half the syrup over. Leave for 10 minutes, then drizzle the remainder.

Cool before turning out.
