Then at 8:30 pm we will move into the Hall for the formal AGM and vote on this unique opportunity at Trevigro Quarry Bottom, everyone's vote is important. Elsewhere in the newsletter is an advert for apple pressing at the Old School, Stoke Climsland. **SHARE** can access similar equipment so if you have apples that you want to turn into juice, that could be organised.

18 people visited the CERC. **Cornwall Energy Recovery Centre**, to see the incinerator in action and the "blue box" turbine, generating energy. We were all impressed by the scale and efficiency of the operation but despaired at the recyclable items we saw being burnt, especially metal and glass.

Sarah our guide particularly noted **All Batteries, MUST NOT be put in general waste** Found in rechargeable devices such as toothbrushes, toys, phones and laptops, batteries have become more powerful in recent years. Smaller, frequently used, and cheaper electronic devices and gadgets - even some musical greeting cards - often have "hidden batteries" and need to be disposed of correctly.

Not only is this wasting lithium but common household batteries when crushed, then when wet and/or high temperatures can cause fires, added to general waste which is highly inflammable, a fire soon accelerates in a waste collection lorry or at the depot !! So please take batteries to your local supermarket, or other retail store, school, library that accepts them or the recycling centres at Saltash or Launceston. 



RECIPE OF THE MONTH

REGULAR OUTINGS



GREEN VEGETABLE QUICHE



INGREDIENTS

Pastry

85g plain flour 85g wholemeal flour 85g block margarine Pinch of salt

Filling

225g courgettes 1/2 green pepper 3 spring onions 1/2 bunch watercress 3 medium eggs 60g grated cheese milk

1 tablespoon oil salt and ground black pepper



METHOP

Line an 8" (21cm) flan dish or ring with the pastry. Prick the base and line with grease proof paper and baking beans. Stand on a baking sheet and bake in centre of oven for 15 minutes (200°C/400°F/Gas Mark 6). Remove paper and beans and bake for a further 5 minutes. Reduce heat to 190°C/375°F/Gas Mark 5).

To make filling - trim and slice courgettes and green pepper. Trim and chop spring onions. Heat oil and gently sauté vegetables for 5 minutes. Transfer to pastry case. Roughly chop watercress, including stalks, and sprinkle over vegetables. Beat eggs and make up to 10 fl oz (300 ml) with milk. Season well and pour over vegetables. Top with grated cheese.

Bake in centre of oven until well risen and golden brown. Serve hot or cold

The next phase is some external pointing work and the restoration of the west door.


