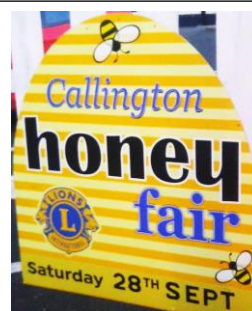

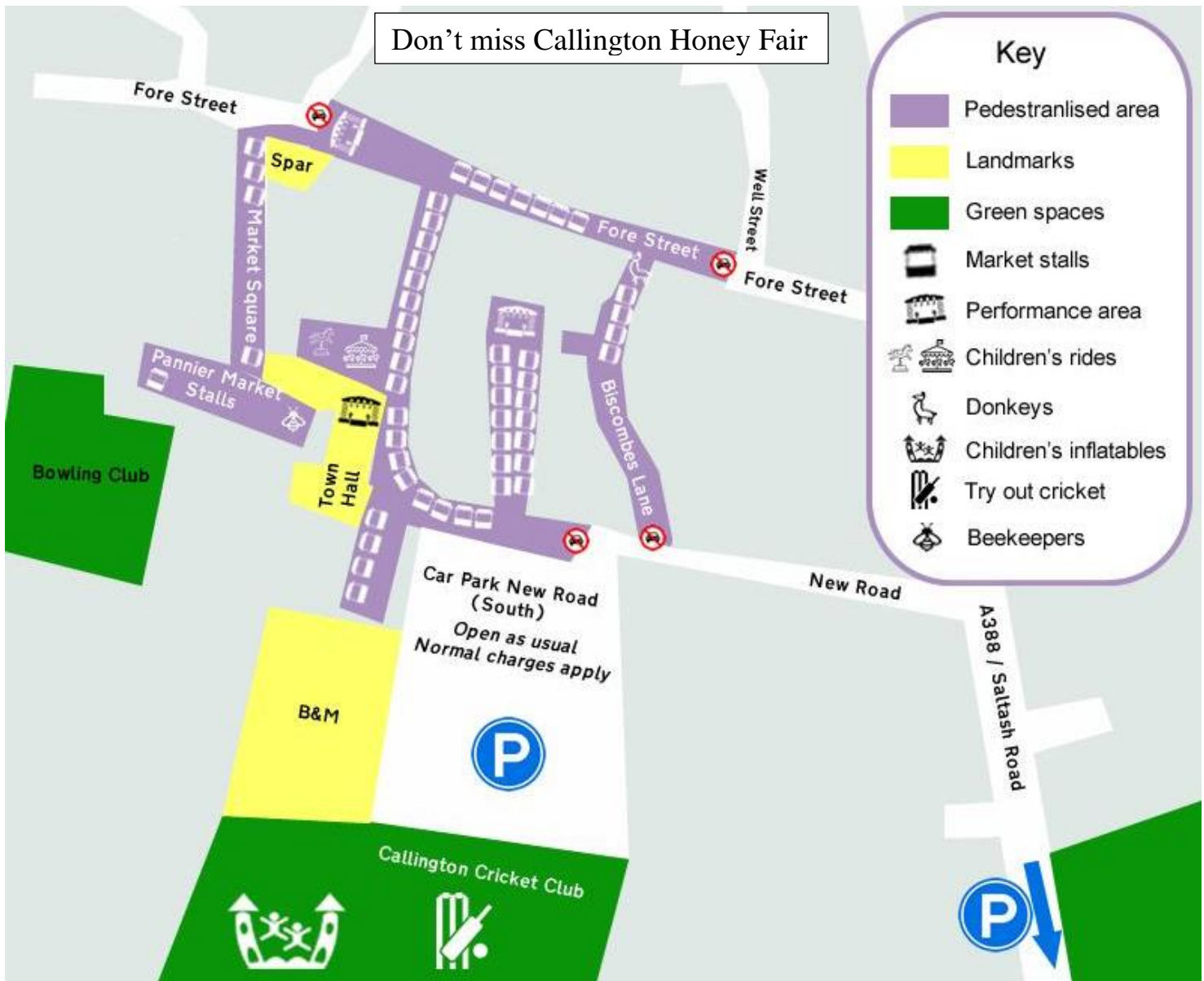

Where has the summer gone! I can't believe that it's now autumn. Time doesn't stop rolling on and nor does our restoration work and all that we do at St Sampson's Church.

We have a new vicar the Rev. Andy Atkins, who is slowly getting to know everyone. He is also the vicar of Calstock benefice. His title is oversight minister and he has eight parishes with 11 churches to minister to! A formal procedure to make Callington and Calstock benefices into one benefice (group) will be put forward soon and everyone will have a legal and democratic chance to have their say, for or against, when that happens. We also have a new family worker, Clare, who joined us in September. We look forward to working with her across the Callington cluster.



A number of grants have been received and we are now able to commence:

- The replacement and repair of the gutters and downpipes on the north side of the church. Many thanks to National Churches Trust, Headley Trust & Cornish Historic Churches Trust.
- The restoration of the tower screen doors. Thanks to Truro Diocese Building Fund for Mission and Worshipful Company of Ironmongers.

We should have funding in place soon for the repairs to the tomb monument in the chancel and the tower repointing.

Various planning permissions and preparation works are ongoing for the toilet, kitchen, Manton chapel, roof and ceiling.

And many thanks to all the helpers and attendees at all our events. Every £1 in the pot makes a real difference to securing the future of St Sampson's Church.

This month 7 members of South Hill WI dressed up in PPE and took a tour of the Suez St Dennis Energy Recovery Centre. We were given the tour led by Sarah Cotton tour manager at Suez, who happens to be local to us here in South Hill.

The facility, surprisingly, was clean with only a vague whiff of the "raw materials". Inside the facility looks like an industrial sci fi film set!



We learned about how it was sorted and the fact that as food waste was still being added to the non-recyclable bin it was pretty wet when it arrived. It is all dried then burned at very high temperatures and provides electricity to thousands of homes via the national grid. Nothing goes to landfill. There are occasional open days but they have educational provision for arranged tours both for adult groups and children.



Our normal meeting was on the subject of History of Photography given by Richard Squires.

Richard brought a huge range of historical cameras and explained about the basics of the process and some of the important milestones and influences.

A lot of the members recalled the cameras as used by our parents rather too long ago to admit! A wonderful talk by Richard and so interesting!

The next meeting of South Hill WI will be on **Wednesday 2nd October** in the Parish Hall, Golberdon at 7.00 pm. The speaker this month will be Mike Stephens who is a local plantsman, and has kindly stepped in at short notice as the programmed speaker is unable to come. He will be talking to us about bulbs for the garden - providing inspiration and temptation as bulbs appear in garden centres, nurseries and supermarkets!

RECIPE OF THE MONTH A VARIATION ON A LANCASHIRE HOTPOT

Fry **2 or 3 large shallots** in a little oil until soft. Add **cubes of lamb** to the pan and fry lightly to brown. Add finely **sliced carrots, 1 aubergine peeled and chopped, a good pinch of Herbes de Provence, a teaspoon of tomato paste, one lamb stock cube** and enough water just to cover.

Place the lid on the pan and simmer over a low heat until the vegetables are soft.

Pour into a casserole dish, and top with **finely sliced potatoes**. Season with sea salt and brush the potatoes with a little oil. Place in a hot oven and cook until the potatoes are cooked and turning golden.

South Hill Parish Council

Details of the council meeting held on 17 September 2024 include the following topics:

PARISH HALL:

Before the formal meeting Mr Chris Beckett, Chairman of the Parish Hall Committee briefed the Council on two items:

a. The work to change the Hall to a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO) continues. The Charity Commission has given permission to proceed and the transfer is expected from 1 Jan 2025. The Parish Council have updated the trustees of the hall, this may result in some modification to the CIO application.

b. Plans to extend the hall were explained, with a new lobby, kitchenette, activity room, and outside disabled toilet. The likely costs of this will be in excess of £100,000. The architect has also produced an additional proposed plan for a path around the Recreation field with extra parking area at the far end of the field. This was supported by the Parish Council.

CORNWALL COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVE:

Cllr Phil Seeva attended the meeting to explain he was to remain as our Cornwall Council replacement for Cllr Sharron Daw (Lynher Ward).

He stated that he was aware the Gardens of Mercy had made an application but as yet the council had not ratified it, so nothing to add at this time.

He has a £3500 Community Chest funding available to any groups within our parish and other parishes he is covering.. Cllr. Seeva then left the meeting. INFO HERE

NEW ALLOTMENTS/ ORCHARD:

The new allotments are not being used and are a mess. It was proposed that this area be cleaned up, with the grass cut and the area used as an entrance area to the orchard. Exact plans for the area e.g. picnic table, shelter, car park will be firmed up after the area has been improved. Thus the council will not be proceeding with the planning application for a new entrance to the orchard.

FOOTPATHS:

Cormac Senior Countryside Officer has indicated that a gate, posts and rail will be delivered soon so that the entrance to Woodlands path can be improved.

Walkers have indicated a number of stiles on paths needing repair, this will be looked at soon.

PLUSHA JUNCTION ON THE A30:

Safety improvement plans for A30 junctions including the Plusha junction will be discussed at an opportunity to meet the improvement team at Lewannick Village Hall on Thursday 26 September 2024 to 6.45pm. Details of this meeting can be found at:
