The NATIONAL Emergency BRIEFING

Last November in Westminster, ten of the UK's leading experts briefed an invited audience of over 1,200 politicians and leaders from business, culture, faith, sport and the media.

It set out the implications of climate and nature breakdown for health, food systems, national security and the economy.

The PEOPLE'S Emergency BRIEFINGS

A film screening across the UK – in public spaces, bringing local residents together with their MP to hear the same evidence.

The audience has a chance to voice how they think and feel about what they have seen.

The NATIONAL Emergency CAMPAIGN

The aim is for the Government to stage a national televised briefing – so every household in the country hears the same evidence – as the first step towards the urgent, large-scale response now needed.
