

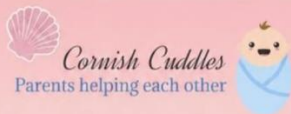

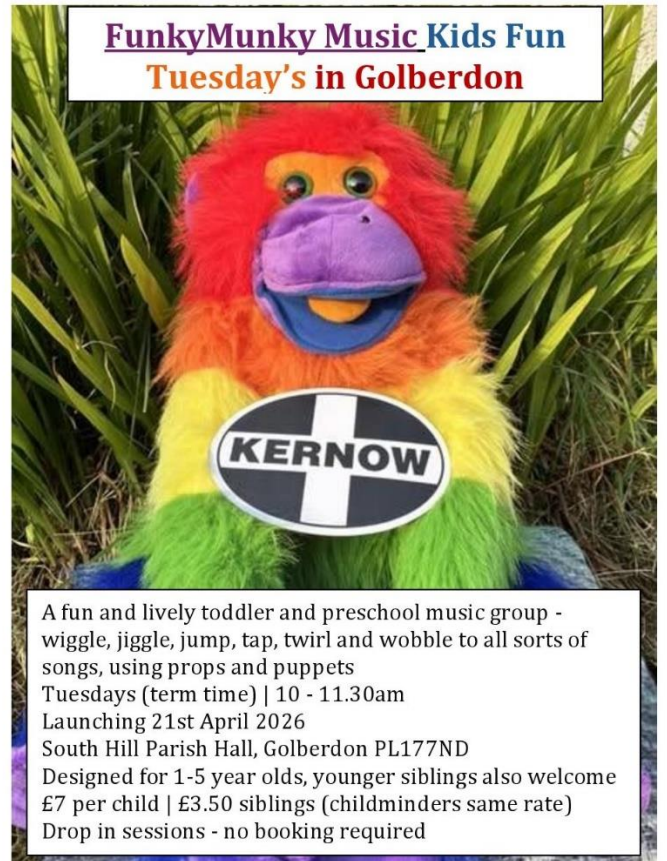

## The Community Orchard update.

Located opposite 1 - 4 Moorland View, Golberdon.

Our volunteers have been busy again, the shelter and deck have been completed with water butts attached, the pumpkin patch has been planted, the gateway improved, wildflowers introduced and encouraged, pathways cut through the tall grass, seating added, strawberries eaten ...

In the shelter there is a blackboard where you can record anything of interest you have spotted. Today some of the stinging nettles were covered in caterpillars.

**Still to do**, cut and remove the tall grass, create a pond area, build raised beds, weed around the trees... sit and enjoy and watch the space evolve.

We have visited National Trust property, Hays Farm, at St. Dominick and The Wildlife Trust, Sylvia's Meadow at St Anne's Chapel during Green Week, this week, to see how they are managing their land and learning about weeds, wildflowers, grasses, bracken, brambles, grazing, mowing and more.

We are planning a visit to Liftondown Quarry where the property has been developed, attracting many species of wildlife.

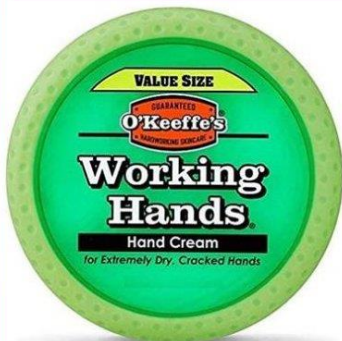
If the tubes or pots aren't totally empty that's OK. The items are processed and then made into new products.
