## Golberdon Working Party (GWP) Affordable Housing update

Cornwall Council has been proactively working with residents of Golberdon, supported by South Hill Parish Council, to help us to understand local housing need and to explore the feasibility of using the land owned by Cornwall Council behind Moorland View for Affordable Housing.

The local Housing Needs survey has identified a local need for 1 and 2 bedroomed properties, it is believed that this would benefit young people and families and older residents wishing to downsize but remain in the area.

The GWP is made up of local residents, who are supported by the Affordable Housing Team and our local Councillor, Jim Gale. We meet every 6- 8 weeks at South Hill Parish Hall to discuss progress and decide on next steps. Anyone is welcome to attend.

Currently the GWP is applying for grant funding from Cornwall Council, this funding will allow us to commission reports eg. From the Highways Department and to prepare initial drawings, this will help us at this early stage to explore the feasibility of future housing development on this site.

## SHARE is in the early stages of looking to set up a local **Energy Club**.

If established, the club would enable locally generated renewable energy to be bought by local consumers at a fair price. By matching local energy demand to local generation, the club could offer households the chance to pay less for power, while helping to build a resilient, environmentally conscious energy network that benefits your pocket, your community and your planet. **To start the local Energy Club, just 30 households will be initially invited to join.**

**Could you be one of the 30 founding Energy Club members?**

**You don't have to be a SHARE member to find out more.**

**Just Answer these Questions:**

- Do you have premises located within South Hill parish or close by?
- Are you unable to have your own solar panels or battery storage. ie you rent the property, have a building not suitable for panels, costs, other reasons?
- Do you have a smart meter or be happy for one to be installed?
- Would you be able to switch your energy supplier, by being either out of contract with your current supplier, or willing to pay an exit fee to them (if required by that company)?
- Would you be prepared to accept a tariff with our supplier that, when locally generated power is not being used, may be higher than some domestic tariffs?
- Would you be able to shift some of your electricity demand (ie. washing clothes, heating hot water) to times of the day when renewable energy is being produced?

If you meet the criteria above, we'd love to have you on board.
